I hope this message finds you well. With colder winter weather now upon us, we wanted to provide a reminder about the importance of students coming to school dressed appropriately for the conditions. While we do call an indoor lunch when temperatures reach -20 or below, students in Grades 7 to 9 are not required to remain indoors.
