STUDENTS IN GR. 6-8 MOVING SCHOOLS NEXT YEAR:

If your child will NOT be attending Arbour Lake School for the 2025-2026 school year, regardless of residency, please use the link below to inform us of your plans. Having an accurate enrollment count is essential for planning the new school year, as enrollment numbers impact our school-wide timetable, homeroom composition, and complementary course offerings. Thank you for providing this information in advance. If your child is transitioning to a new school, we are happy to support their move to another CBE school or any other institution they plan to attend. **This does not apply to Grade 9 students.** Grade 9 students are automatically rolled over to their designated high school, and no action is required.

OUT OF BOUNADRY STUDENTS:

As we begin planning for the 2025-2026 school year, a notification was previously sent home to families of students attending Arbour Lake School who reside outside our designated boundaries. This notification informed parents that their child's enrollment at Arbour Lake School for the 2025-2026 school year is not guaranteed. The communities designated to Arbour Lake School are Arbour Lake, Citadel, and Hawkwood, as well as grandfathered students from Scenic Acres (provided their enrollment began prior to the 2024-2025 school year). If you do not reside in one of these communities and your child is not enrolled in The Class or the Literacy and Learning program, they are considered an out-of-boundary registration. According to administrative regulations, out-of-boundary registrations must be reviewed on a

yearly basis.

If your child falls into this category, please use the link below to complete the attached form. You will be asked to provide information that will be reviewed as we assess available resources at Arbour Lake School for the 2025-2026 school year and determine whether we can continue to accommodate current out-of-boundary students.
